



BREEZE LOGISTICS – HIRE EQUIPMENT TRADING TERMS – EFFECTIVE 1st JULY 2014

As of the 1st July 2014 Breeze logistics will be changing their hire equipment trading terms to align with the industry standards of carrier and warehousing facilities. Suppliers are required to adhere to the following trading terms that apply to both interstate and local transport and Cold Storage.

HIRE EQUIPMENT ACCEPTED

- Breeze Logistics will only accept Chep and Loscam wooden pallets
- Hire equipment other than wooden pallets are not permitted to be transferred onto our accounts without prior approval from Breeze Senior Management.
- Any wooden pallet other than Chep and Loscam (i.e. skids, plain pallets) will be at the suppliers expense.
- Breeze Logistics do exchange pallets with Suppliers that do not have a Chep or Loscam accounts through an Exchange register which adheres to the Breeze Logistics Exchange policy and Procedure.
- Breeze Logistics Cold Storage pick up exchange with non Breeze carriers on a pallet for pallet basis (i.e. 1 chep for 1 chep). Pallets must be provided prior to stock being released as transfers onto carriers will not be raised without prior approval.

TRANSFER REQUIREMENTS

- All delivered into Breeze Logistics Cold Storage and all pick up by Breeze Logistics Refrigerated transport must be accompanied with an equipment transfer docket
- Breeze Logistics will not raise equipment transfers on behalf of the supplier/carrier at any time
- Breeze Logistics accept the following transfer types CMD (Chep movement docket), Chepmate and Chep Portfolio
- Breeze Logistics accept the following Loscam transfer types: ECD (equipment control docket), Loscam Online and HMS (Hire Management System)
- Breeze logistics accept 2ic and Pallet Watch generated dockets for both Chep and Loscam
- Breeze Logistics do not advise of transfers on to our accounts. It is the responsibility of the sending party
- All transfers onto Breeze Logistics are subject to a 30 day delay from date of shipment/despatch. Transfers not processed with the 30 day delay will be corrected accordingly.
- Breeze Logistics encourage a Chep EDO (effective date offset) for suppliers transferring onto the Breeze Chep account.
- Suppliers and carriers have 6 months from shipment/despatch date to advise of transfers onto Breeze Logistics accounts. Transfers outside this period will not be accepted by Breeze Logistics.
